**FRANK LEONI**

**WM Head Baseball Coach  
Camp Director**

Coach Leoni is in his 4<sup>th</sup> year as the head baseball coach at William & Mary. Before coming to Williamsburg, he was the head coach at his alma mater, the University of Rhode Island, for 13 seasons. During his stint at URI, Coach Leoni was named the Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year twice, and won an A-10 Championship in 2005. In 2008, the Tribe finished the season 36-21, which was good for the 2<sup>nd</sup> most wins in school history. The 2008 Tribe also had 4 players selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, a school record.

**JAD PRACHNIAK**  
**WM Pitching Coach**

Coach Prachniak played four years under Coach Leoni ('01-'04) at the University of Rhode Island and spent a year coaching there as well ('05). Prachniak has spent the last four seasons working with the Tribe pitching staff. Since coming to WM Prachniak has had three of his pitchers selected in the MLB Draft. Leoni and Prachniak have been involved in over 100 wins at WM since 2006.

**KYLE PADGETT**  
**WM Assistant coach**

After a successful career at William & Mary ended in 2005, Coach Padgett was drafted in the 18<sup>th</sup> round by the Florida Marlins. Coach Padgett concluded his playing career in 2007 to become a volunteer assistant coach with the Tribe in 2008. He spent the fall of 2008 at Wake Forest as a volunteer assistant coach, before coming back to Williamsburg to rejoin the Tribe staff for the 2009 season.

**TIM PARK**  
**WM Volunteer Assistant**

Coach Park finished an outstanding playing career with the Tribe in 2008. He is in the WM record books several times, including career leader in batting average. Park coaches the hitters, catchers and outfielders at WM.
